World Champion Paracyclist Mark Rohan announced as Renault Ireland Ambassador



Renault Ireland today announced World Champion Paralympian Mark Rohan as a brand ambassador and the face of Renault's sponsorship of the 2012 Irish Paralympic Team. Thirty-year old Mark, who is from Ballinahown Co Westmeath, qualified for his first Paralympic Games by winning gold at the UCI Paracycling Road World Championships in Denmark last Saturday (10th Sept.) and is considered a serious contender to medal at the Games in London next year. Rohan also made paracycling history in August becoming the first ever athlete to win 6 World Cup Gold Medals in a row. He had double Gold Medal wins in both Sydney in May and Segovia, Spain in July and a further double gold in Canada in August and is the current holder of the World Leader Jersey.

“Mark is an athlete that embodies Renault and Paralympics Ireland values and he truly is inspiring beyond belief. We are all fully behind Mark and his team mates as they prepare for the Paralympic Games in London 2012 and we are delighted that Mark will represent Ireland and Renault on this challenging and truly rewarding journey for Paralympics Ireland” said Eric Basset, managing director of Renault Ireland.
